

Details of the Revisions

1. Details of revisions in description forms for drawings

(1) Details of revisions

Although standards for "FACE TO FACE OR END TO END," "CONNECTION" are indicated in the "Standards" field on the present drawings among applicable standards, the information is not indicated in the "Pressure test." The ways of describing standards are inconsistent between "Standards" and "Pressure test" fields on the drawing. In addition, it is ambiguous whether the "Pressure test" is based on "test standards by public standards" or "test standards by manufacturer standards."

In order to improve the situation, the pre-existing "Standards" and "Pressure test" fields are combined to form a new "Standards" field to provide information for "FACE TO FACE OR END TO END," "END CONNECTION," "WALL THICKNESS" and "PRESSURE TESTS."

This new "Standards" field clarifies which standards, public or manufacturer standards, are applied for individual items, as well as the specific names of the standards.

Reference information:

* The "Public standards" stated above refers to publicly-established standards such as JIS standards, for example, JIS B2011 (Bronze valves) and JIS B2031 (Gray cast iron valves), and API standards.

* The "manufacturer Standards" stated above refers to test standards which we voluntarily specified as appropriate considering public standards.

(2) Acquisition of product test pressure values

When you need to know the specific test pressure values of applied standards indicated on drawings, please contact our sales representative. We will also provide the test pressure list on our website so that the information is directly available to our customers. This is scheduled as from January 5, 2009. We hope this will help you as well.

2. Schedules for these revisions

(1) These revisions will be applied to drawing for products ordered as from January 5, 2009.
